this timely book provides an extensive account of national identities in three of the constituent nations of the united kingdom wales scotland and england in all three contexts identity and nationalism have become questions of acute interest in both academic and political commentary the authors take stock of a wealth of empirical material and explore how attitudes to nation and state can be understood by relating them to changes in contemporary capitalist economies and the consequences for particular class fractions the book argues that these changes give rise to a set of resentments among people who perceive themselves to be losing out concluding that class resentments depending on historical and political factors relevant to each nation can take the form of either sub state nationalism or right wing populism nation class and resentment shows that the politics of resentment is especially salient in england where the promotion of a distinct national identity is problematic students and scholars across a range of disciplines including sociology and politics will find this study of interest

this cutting edge collection presents a political reading of the power of modern sport in asia providing an interdisciplinary study of political and cultural tensions in asia past and present through the key case study of sport it illuminates the complex practices and legacies of japanese imperialism across east and southeast asia through the 20th century and beyond focusing on the deep background to contemporary dynamics of intraregional tensions it examines sport both as a tool of imperialism and as an agent of reconciliation as the region gears up to the 2020 olympics in tokyo offering a unique contribution to east asian studies colonial and postcolonial studies and sport studies this work represent key reading for students and scholars of east asian studies international politics and sports diplomacy

the author's starting point is the interweaving of forgiveness and resentment in the works of Jewish writers after the Holocaust most especially Hannah Arendt and Jean Améry to make sense of the catastrophe and to point to a way forward for both victims and perpetrators the insights of these two writers and of several Jewish novelists and poets including Bruno Schulz Paul Celan and Aharon Appelfeld are used to develop accounts of forgiveness and resentment in other cases of mass atrocity around the world the author offers a critical rereading of primary sources that aim to separate resentment from nonviolent resistance and forgiveness from reconciliation forgiveness and resentment are not as they might first appear mutually exclusive together with Arendt Améry and Walter Benjamin it is argued that it is through the interaction between them that victims of mass atrocity become agents of personal and cultural change together forgiveness and resentment interrupt the present reframe the past and shape the future they can reduce the chasm that separates memory and trust by fashioning new connections between identity and alterity which can open paths to truly ethical coexistence for victims and perpetrators and their descendants

Cramer uncovers an oft overlooked piece of the puzzle rural political consciousness and the resentment of the liberal elite rural voters are distrustful that politicians will respect the distinct values of their communities and allocate a fair share of resources what can look like disagreements about basic political principles are therefore actually rooted in something even more fundamental who we are as people and how closely a candidate's social identity

matches our own taking a deep dive into wisconsin s political climate cramer illuminates the contours of rural consciousness showing how place based identities profoundly influence how people understand politics the politics of resentment shows that rural resentment no less than partisanship race or class plays a major role in dividing america against itself

the new york times bestselling author of the origins of political order offers a provocative examination of modern identity politics its origins its effects and what it means for domestic and international affairs of state in 2014 francis fukuyama wrote that american institutions were in decay as the state was progressively captured by powerful interest groups two years later his predictions were borne out by the rise to power of a series of political outsiders whose economic nationalism and authoritarian tendencies threatened to destabilize the entire international order these populist nationalists seek direct charismatic connection to the people who are usually defined in narrow identity terms that offer an irresistible call to an in group and exclude large parts of the population as a whole demand for recognition of one s identity is a master concept that unifies much of what is going on in world politics today the universal recognition on which liberal democracy is based has been increasingly challenged by narrower forms of recognition based on nation religion sect race ethnicity or gender which have resulted in anti immigrant populism the upsurge of politicized islam the fractious identity liberalism of college campuses and the emergence of white nationalism populist nationalism said to be rooted in economic motivation actually springs from the demand for recognition and therefore cannot simply be satisfied by economic means the demand for identity cannot be transcended we must begin to shape identity in a way that supports rather than undermines democracy identity is an urgent and necessary book a sharp warning that unless we forge a universal understanding of human dignity we will doom ourselves to continuing conflict

forgiveness is important in international politics because it can save thousands of lives its opposite vengefulness has played a significant part in various wars of the 20th and 21st centuries these conflicts are examined in this book showing how forgiveness could have avoided the tremendous ensuing bloodshed despite its importance in the context of international relations forgiveness as a means of preventing the outbreak of war as opposed to facilitating reconciliation after conflicts has largely been neglected as a subject of study indeed it has also been ignored by politicians as a result of which there are few examples of forgiveness to study compared with those of revenge this book reflects this reality but also seeks to change it by raising public awareness of the importance of forgiveness in international affairs and the need to demand that political leaders explore this avenue the book also provides a succinct informative guide to the background of today s international affairs each chapter can be read independently and highlights either forgiveness in action or the futility and loss of life caused by vengefulness demonstrating where and how forgiveness could have made a dramatic difference

an innovative reassessment of philosopher p f strawson s influential freedom and resentment p f strawson was one of the most important philosophers of the twentieth century and his 1962 paper freedom and resentment is one of the most influential in modern moral philosophy prompting responses across multiple disciplines from psychology to sociology in freedom resentment and the metaphysics of morals pamela hieronymi closely reexamines strawson s paper and concludes that his argument has been underestimated and misunderstood line by line hieronymi carefully untangles the complex strands of strawson s ideas after elucidating his conception of moral responsibility and his division between reactive and objective responses to the actions and attitudes of others hieronymi turns to his central argument strawson argues that because determinism is an entirely general thesis true of everyone at all times its truth does not undermine moral responsibility hieronymi finds the two common interpretations of this argument the simple humane

interpretation and the broadly wittgensteinian interpretation both deficient drawing on strawson s wider work in logic philosophy of language and metaphysics hieronymi concludes that his argument rests on an implicit and previously overlooked metaphysics of morals one grounded in strawson s social naturalism in the final chapter she defends this naturalistic picture against objections rigorous concise and insightful freedom resentment and the metaphysics of morals sheds new light on strawson s thinking and has profound implications for future work on free will moral responsibility and metaethics the book also features the complete text of strawson s freedom and resentment

situating these representations within the context of victorian visual culture and offering new readings of key works by charles dickens elizabeth gaskell ellen wood george eliot oscar wilde and arthur conan doyle jaffe shows how mid victorian spectacles of social difference constructed the middle class self and how late victorian narratives of feeling paved the way for the sympathetic affinities of contemporary identity politics book jacket

in current debates about coming to terms with individual and collective wrongdoing the concept of forgiveness has played an important but controversial role for a long time the idea was widespread that a forgiving attitude overcoming feelings of resentment and the desire for revenge was always virtuous recently however this idea has been questioned the contributors to this volume do not take sides for or against forgiveness but rather examine its meaning and function against the backdrop of a more complex understanding of moral repair in a variety of social circumstantial and cultural contexts the book aims to gain a differentiated understanding of the european traditions regarding forgiveness revenge and moral repair that have shaped our moral intuitions today whilst also examining examples from other cultural contexts asia and africa in particular to explore how different cultural traditions deal with the need for moral repair after wrongdoing

in recent years the humanities social sciences and neuroscience have witnessed an affective turn especially in discourses around post fordist labor economic and ecological crises populism and identity politics mental health and political struggle this new awareness would be unthinkable without the pioneering work of gilles deleuze who replaced judgment with affect as the very material movement of thought every concept is an affective experience a becoming besides entirely active affects the highest practice of thought there is no thought without passive affects or passions instead of a calm and rational philosophy of passions deleuzian thought is therefore inseparable from isolated and passionate cries that deny what everybody knows and what nobody can deny every true thought is an aggression this inseparability of reason and passion is by no means an anti intellectualist or irrationalist stance rather it is critical since it protects reason from its self imposed stupidity *bêtise* by relating it to the unthought forces that condition it and it is clinical because thought becomes possessed by a power of selection the purely active i e free floating unrecorded desire is never enough to produce a consistent relation to the future which is why we need the passions to give us an initial orientation to force and enable us to think passions are the beliefs
