colonial governments reacted to counter hegemonic songs through repression banning songs from distribution and or broadcast while often targeting the musicians with acts of intimidation in an attempt to silence them in the post independence era a disturbing trend has occurred in which african governments have regularly continued to practise censorship of musicians however not all attempts to silence musicians have emanated from government nor has all contested music been strictly political religious and moral rationale has also featured prominently in censorship struggles both christian and muslim fundamentalism has led to extreme attempts to silence musicians in response musicians have often sought ways of getting their music and message heard despite censorship and harassment the book includes a special section on case studies that highlight issues of nationality
