it s the fall of 1942 and the second world war rages on the skies above britain and the oceans around her are a battleground german bombers target cities like liverpool and crewe while u boats and warships prowl the waters between england and france ten year old evelyn jackson and her parents live on rations waiting for the sounds of the air raid sirens above them and wondering what will come of their far flung family in times of war eve stands tall through bombings and evacuations through an unfair beating and a paralyzing illness and survives with her smile and her generous heart still intact meanwhile one of her uncles submariner dominic king serves aboard hms tuna dominic the boats helmsman and along with the crew were under constant threat of german u boats and aircraft as they complete their ever demanding war patrols from delivering marine commandos off the coast of france to protecting the arctic convoys in the north atlantic acting leading seaman dominic king would go on to be awarded the distinguished service medal by king george vi at buckingham palace for his bravery and courage while under fire in events in their lives would bring them both together at the edge of the war many families have stories like this from mothers and grandmothers this one is michael s his majesty s sailor and the girl in the blue coat presents heartfelt historical fiction based on real events and stories passed down from the people who were there

when the R101 first took to the skies she was the largest aircraft ever to fly what followed was a tragic finale to a tale of human folly on a grand scale i loved every page of this book the times best history books of 2023 in 1929 the R101 was the largest object ever to take to the air it was meant to dazzle the world with cutting edge technology and awesome size better than a plane more luxurious than an ocean liner the R101 would connect the furthest reaches of the british empire tying together far flung dominions at a time when imperial bonds were fraying it was however not to be the spectacular crash of the british airship R101 in 1930 changed the world of aviation forever most have heard of the fiery crash of the hindenburg a german ship that went down in new jersey seven years later but the story of R101 and its forty eight victims has largely been forgotten his majesty's airship recounts the epic narrative of the ill fated airship and her eccentric champion christopher thomson s c gwynne brings to life a lost world of aviators driven by ambition and killed by hubris

the long forgotten story of the sinking of the R M S leinster in the dying days of the first world war is brought back to life in this tale of the disaster the book tells the stories of those on board the leinster and UB 123 and examines not only the sinking but also its ramifications for those left behind

a washington post notable book in march 1941 after a year of devastating u boat attacks the british war cabinet turned to an intensely private bohemian physicist named patrick blackett to turn the tide of the naval campaign though he is little remembered today blackett did as much as anyone to defeat nazi germany by revolutionizing the allied anti submarine effort through the disciplined systematic implementation of simple mathematics and probability theory this is the story of how british and american civilian intellectuals helped change the nature of twentieth century warfare by convincing disbelieving military brass to trust the new field of operational research

no survivors during the cold war the history of submarines including the hunley a confederate submarine during the us civil war which was the first sub to ever sink a ship though it did so kamikaze style what a submarine base is like how a soviet sub in the mediterranean was flushed out earning the crew a crate of champagne from america the author s personal experience with the polaris and trident classes of submarine and more interesting sometimes thought provoking but above all an entertaining read nuclear futures

germany s high seas fleet in the world war is a book by reinhard scheer admiral in the imperial german navy which deals with the campaigns of the famous german fleet during the first world war the high seas fleet or hochseeflotte was the battle fleet of the german imperial navy and saw action during the great war in the first part of the book scheer deals with the first two years of the war from the outbreak to the battle of jutland skagerrak the second part covers the period from the battle of the jutland to the unrestricted u boat warfare it describes the battle of jutland and its aftermaths leading to the u boat campaign the third and final part of the book deals with the u boat campaign a naval campaign fought by german u boats against the trade routes of the allies

a staggering new account of the civilian death toll of the world wars and what it reveals about the true nature and cost of modern war soldiers have never been the only casualties of wars but the armies that fought world wars i and ii killed far more civilians than soldiers as they countenanced or deliberately inflicted civilian deaths on a mass scale by one reputable estimate 9 7 million civilians and 9 million combatants died in world war i while world war ii killed 25 5 million civilians and 15 million combatants but in the hidden victims cormac [?] gr [?] da argues that even these shocking numbers are almost certainly too low carefully evaluating all the evidence available he estimates that the wars cost not 35 million but some 65 million civilian lives nearly two thirds of the 100 million total killed indeed he shows that war induced famines alone may have killed 30 million people making them the single largest cause of death the hidden victims is the first book to attempt to measure and describe the full scale of civilian deaths during the world wars from all causes including genocide starvation aerial bombardment and disease while nations went to great lengths to record military casualties they often didn t count or deliberately obscured civilian deaths getting the numbers right is important it reveals much about the true human costs of the wars the nature of modern warfare and the failure of efforts to stop civilian casualties it also makes it possible to argue with those who try to deny minimize or exaggerate wartime savagery

two yellowing envelopes in a long untouched file unmistakably of u s army origin but addressed to a north carolina housewife caught the attention of her son as he sorted her papers after her death the postmarks virginia beach va and dated in 1942 were

puzzling as was the official return address 111th infantry c t mobile defense force while the 111th regimental combat team could be deciphered the mobile defense force was not a recognizable term the letters inside instructed her on the duties of a coast watcher and evoked memories stored since childhood the sickening thump of torpedoes striking u s ships just off the currituck outer banks and the flare of flames particularly when a tanker was hit that were clear even to a youngster on his front porch 8 miles inland each boom and pillar of fire revealed that more men were dying in the freezing waters off north carolina s barrier islands that winter how did the united states get into such straits that its life was threatened as the axis juggernauts rolled across western europe and asia what transpired during the crucial years when the outcome of the war could go against the united states as axis aggression flooded the atlantic with u boats striving to cut the stream of ships laden with weapons troops and food flowing to the beleaguered british isles the last allied outpost near the continent how did the allies achieve victory first against the u boats then the war for as napoleon observed it is only a step from victory to disaster

following the death of colonel sir jasper speedicut in 1915 the speedicut saga continues with the publication of the memoirs of his son charles it is clear from his hair raising exploits in pre and post revolutionary russia and in the sands of arabia interspersed with adventures in a whole range of other people s bedrooms that charles speedicut inherited not just his name from his father

in february 1917 german u boats launched a savage unrestricted campaign against both allied and neutral shipping at its peak in april 860 000 tons of allied merchant shipping was sunk britain s supremacy at sea was being severely challenged and with it the chances of victory in the wider war taking up the challenge was britain s new first sea lord sir john jellicoe until the previous december c in c of the grand fleet famously described by churchill as the only man who could have lost the war in an afternoon the battle he now faced was equally critical although the timeline of defeat was a matter of days rather than hours britain s food stocks were dangerously low with wheat reserves down to six weeks and sugar to only two while wide scale shortages were crippling the industrial economy jellicoe outlined the gravity of the situation with total candor to rear admiral william sims usn sent over before america officially declared war by franklin roosevelt the assistant secretary of the navy the two men already knew each other from service together in china during the boxer rebellion so jellicoe s plea for urgent american assistance was taken seriously by sims after the usa joined the war in april 1917 together they lobbied washington for aid addressing their needs directly to two reluctant anglophobes at the head of the usn secretary of the navy josephus daniels and chief of naval operations william benson clearly a radical new approach to anti submarine warfare was called for and convoy was the leading contender there were many objections to protecting shipping in this way some ideological but most practical a workable system for example effectively required state control of both shipping and distribution networks something inconceivable in normal circumstances however convoy had

powerful advocates including the prime minister lloyd george who later claimed he had personally forced its adoption on a reluctant admiralty this self serving political myth cast jellicoe as an opponent of convoy nothing could be further from the truth as both jellicoe and sims understood the key requirement was a rapid increase in the number of destroyers for escort duties america provided them the first arriving in queenstown ireland on 4 may and by june 46 were operating in european waters this was the first step in an anglo american campaign that gradually brought the u boat threat under control and led to its ultimate defeat this book takes a fresh look at the undersea war as a whole and all the complex factors bearing on the campaign only one of which was convoy its analysis is original and its conclusions thought provoking an important contribution to the naval history of the great war

submariners are a tight knit group of men bound together by training and experience and with a language all their own that language is perhaps a little vulgar but never intentionally demeaning and a little irreverent but still worldly this work is an attempt to preserve and explain some of these curious guys who so proudly wear a shiny metal pin that looks like a strange pair of fish on their left breast this process of accumulating this new language begins in boot camp and is added to with every change of duty station the sailor undergoes it is heard aboard the boats and unknowingly by family members who can't understand terms like head deck and overhead and who think sos is a distress signal

flame throwers spy trees bird bombs and hell fighters were all a part of world war i but you won't learn that in your history books uncover long lost secrets of spies like howard burnham the one legged wonder and nurse turned spy edith cavell peek into secret files to learn the truth about the red baron and the mysterious mata hari then learn how to build your own zeppelin balloon and mix up some invisible ink it's all part of the true stories from the top secret files world war i take a look if you dare but be careful some secrets are meant to stay hidden ages 9 12

blunder was probably a matter of life or death and caused by a decision taken under the stress and pressure of combat

investigating the employment of british aircraft against german submarines during the final years of the first world war this new book places anti submarine campaigns from the air in the wider history of the first world war the royal naval air service invested heavily in aircraft of all types aeroplanes seaplanes airships and kite balloons in order to counter the german u boats under the royal air force the air campaign against u boats continued uninterrupted aircraft bombed german u boat bases in flanders conducted area and hunting patrols around the coasts of britain and escorted merchant convoys to safety despite the fact that aircraft acting alone destroyed only one u boat during the war the overall contribution of naval aviation to foiling u boat attacks was significant only five merchant vessels succumbed to submarine attack when convoyed by a combined air and surface escort during world war i this book examines aircraft and weapons technology aircrew training and the aircraft production issues that shaped this campaign then a close examination of anti submarine operations bombing patrols and escort yields a significantly different judgment from existing interpretations of these operations this study is the first to take an objective look at the writing and publication of the naval and air official histories as they told the story of naval aviation during the great war the author also examines the german view of aircraft effectiveness through german actions prisoner interrogations official histories and memoirs to provide a comparative judgment the conclusion closes with a brief narrative of post war air anti submarine developments and a summary of findings overall the author concludes that despite the challenges of organization training and production the employment of aircraft against u boats was largely successful during the great war this book will be of interest to historians of naval and air power history as well as students of world war i and military history in general

clay blair's best selling naval classic silent victory the u s submarine war against japan is regarded as the definitive account of that decisive phase of the war in the pacific nine years in the making hitler's u boat war is destined to become the definitive account of the german submarine war against the allies or the battle of the atlantic it is an epic sea story the most arduous and prolonged naval battle in all history for a period of nearly six years the german u boat force attempted to blockade and isolate the british isles in hopes of forcing the british out of the war thereby thwarting the allied strategic air assault on german cities as well as overlord the allied invasion of occupied france fortunately for the allies the u boat force failed to achieve either of these objectives but in the attempt they sank 2 800 allied merchant ships while the allies sank nearly 800 u boats on both sides tens of thousands of sailors perished the top secret allied penetration of german naval codes and conversely the top secret german penetration of allied naval codes played important roles in the atlantic naval battle in order to safeguard the secrets of codebreaking in the postwar years london and washington agreed to withhold all official codebreaking and u boat records thus for decade upon decade an authoritative and definitive history of the battle of the atlantic could not be attempted the accounts that did appear were

incomplete and full of errors of fact and false interpretations and conclusions often leaving the entirely wrong impression that the german u boats came within a whisker of defeating the allies a myth that persists when london and washington finally began to release the official records in the 1980s clay blair and his wife joan commenced work on this history in washington london and germany they relied on the official records as well as the work of german british american and canadian naval scholars who published studies of bits and pieces of the story the end result is this magnificent and monumental work crammed with vivid and dramatic scenes of naval actions and dispassionate but startling new revelations and interpretations and conclusions about all aspects of the battle of the atlantic the blair history will be published in two volumes this first volume the hunters covers the first three years of the war august 1939 to august 1942 told chronologically it is subdivided into two major sections the war against the british empire and the war against the americas volume ii the hunted to follow a year later will cover the last years of the naval war in europe august 1942 to may 1945 when the allies finally overcame the u boat threat never before has hitler's u boat war been chronicled with such authority fidelity objectivity and detail nothing is omitted even those who fought the battle of the atlantic will find no end of surprises later generations will benefit by having at hand an account of this important phase of world war ii free of bias and mythology

corrado pirzio biroli offers a robust defense of the life and career of his great grandfather grand admiral alfred von tirpitz in this engaging family history as the creator of the modern german navy the trusted adviser of wilhelm ii for two decades and an eminence grise during the weimar republic tirpitz was a central figure in european politics for several decades while tirpitz agonized about hitler's rising power he could not prevent it and he felt as though he was too old to assume dictatorial powers if he had done so he would have liked to have upheld the reichstag which he had always shown respect and counted on drawing on personal recollections unpublished family papers and thoughtful analysis the text reveals how tirpitz had to adapt to a rapidly changing world in which his country went from being a juggernaut that traditional powers tried to rein in to a pariah nation trace four generations of one of europe's most interesting families and discover how tirpitz proved to be a visionary leader in this account of one of history's most misunderstood and important figures

originally printed in 1946 at the order of vice admiral lockwood commander of submarines pacific fleet united states submarine losses memorializes the 374 officers and 3131 men lost at sea between 1941 and 1945 it also chronicles the gallantry and persistence of these men who under the most difficult conditions possible performed critical missions and almost single handedly decimated japan's merchant fleet to those whose contribution meant the loss of sons brothers or husbands in this war admiral lockwood noted in a speech given on navy day 1945 i can assure you that they went down fighting and that their brothers who survived them took a grim toll of our savage enemy to avenge their deaths may god rest their gallant souls this book is a testament to all those living and dead who served in the silent service in wwii this enhanced softbound edition features the entire original text and includes an official appendix of axis submarine losses

starting weeks after hitler declared war on the united states in mid december 1941 and lasting until the war with germany was all but over 73 german u boats sustainably attacked new england waters from montauk new york to the tip of nova scotia at cape sable fifteen percent of these boats were sunk by allied counter attacks five surrendered in the region and three were sunk off new england block island massachusetts bay and off nantucket these have proven appealing to divers with a result that at least three german naval officers or ratings are buried in new england one having killed himself in the boston jail cell there were 34 allied merchant or naval ships sunk by these subs one of them the eagle was not admitted to have been sunk by the germans until decades later over 1 100 men were thrown in the water and 545 of them made it ashore in new england ports 428 were killed importantly saboteurs were landed three places long island frenchman's bay maine and new brunswick canada and boston was mined very little was known about this

the first of two volumes covering the career histories of all of the u boats which saw action in world war ii the histories of some 1200 vessels are covered and each entry aims to be easily accessible every aspect of a boat's activities are covered from laying the keel to its ultimate fate each entry gives locations and dates of units and any boats served with commanders number of patrols undertaken ships sunk along with names of vessels and locations incidents of note re fuelling by u tankers and supply ships attacks on shipping survivors picked up and finally the ultimate fate appendices allow cross referencing and contain such material as deutsches feldpost numbers
