the twenty first century needs a new paradigm for philosophy because both anglo american and continental philosophy have ended in analytic sterility and deconstructive nihilism they have ignored the radical reality of human life which all other realities must presuppose three european philosophers in the twentieth century dilthey heidegger and ortega y gasset began to develop this idea but never before has it been systematically conceptualized and adequately expounded with reference to the works of these philosophers this book examines the major categories and essential properties of human life as it is lived for example in time circumstance history and understanding

the art world has been discovered by criminals as an effective way for money laundering and other clandestine activities on an international level unfortunately in most countries investigators prosecutors judges and regulatory agencies are not equipped to accurately detect investigate and prosecute this type of criminal activity also regulation and international laws and treaties involving the art world have many loopholes that can potentially lead to the laundering of large sums of money this book provides a bird s eye view of novel ways in which money laundering happens through illegal activities involving art it can serve as a guide for law enforcement prosecutors judges and others involved in efforts to curb money laundering and financing of terrorism revealing why somehow new techniques used by criminals have been neglected by law enforcement in most countries drawing from his own experience with the matter in both brazil and in the united states the author makes a case for broader institutional and regulatory improvement extending beyond mere regulation of the art market

after francisco franco s victory in the spanish civil war a great many of the country s intellectuals went into exile in mexico during the three and a half decades of francoist dictatorship these exiles held that the republic not francoism represented the authentic culture of spain in this environment as sebastiaan faber argues in exile and cultural hegemony the spaniards conception of their role

as intellectuals changed markedly over time the first study of its kind to place the exiles ideological evolution in a broad historical context exile and cultural hegemony takes into account developments in both spanish and mexican politics from the early 1930s through the 1970s faber pays particular attention to the intellectuals persistent nationalism and misplaced illusions of pan hispanist grandeur which included awkward and ironic overlaps with the rhetoric employed by their enemies on the francoist right this embrace of nationalism together with the intellectuals dependence on the increasingly authoritarian mexican regime and the international climate of the cold war eventually caused them to abandon the gramscian ideal of the intellectual as political activist in favor of a more liberal apolitical stance preferred by among others the spanish philosopher jose ortega y gasset with its comprehensive approach to topics integral to spanish culture both students of and those with a general interest in twentieth century spanish literature history or culture will find exile and cultural hegemony a fascinating and groundbreaking work

beginning with the restoration of the bourbon monarchy in 1875 and ending with the death of general francisco franco in 1975 this book explores the intersection of education and nationalism in spain based on a broad range of archival and published sources including parliamentary and ministerial records pedagogical treatises and journals teachers manuals memoirs and a sample of over two hundred primary and secondary school textbooks the study examines ideological and political conflict among groups of elites seeking to shape popular understanding of national history and identity through the schools both public and private a burgeoning literature on european nationalisms has posited that educational systems in general and an instrumentalized version of national history in particular have contributed decisively to the articulation and transmission of nationalist ideologies the spanish case reveals a different dynamic in spain a chronically weak state a divided and largely undemocratic political class and an increasingly polarized social and political climate impeded the construction of an effective system of national education and the emergence of a consensus on the shape and meaning of the spanish national past this in turn contributed to one of the most striking features of modern spanish political and cultural life the absence of a strong sense of spanish as opposed to local or regional identity scholars with interests in modern european cultural politics processes of state consolidation nationalism and the history of education will find this book essential reading

this history of the brazilian family in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries studies the relationship between the informal institution of the family and such formal social institutions as medicine the law organized politics and the church the author focuses primarily on middle and upper class families for whom adequate documentation is available and shows the change from a patriarchal model of the family to one that was more conjugal and nuclear a change necessitated by an insecure and urbanizing economy nevertheless bahian families maintained many traditional values and traditional kin networks the author examines the daily life and dynamics of households including what is known about lower class families where consensual arrangements were the norm he looks at the

history of the medical profession the legal profession and the catholic church and he describes the attempts of each group to mobilize the family for its own political social and cultural ends the author argues that family ideology and families themselves resisted and transformed the efforts of these institutions to impose their will the book also deals with the changes and continuities in bahian attitudes and beliefs about courtship honor and the place of women as well as the ways in which bahians projected a familial ethic onto social relations outside the home within families conduct was governed by a belief in the traditional rituals of life in the family circle weekly family dinners at the table of an older relative residence in family compounds around an old mansion or in several apartments of a single building nepotism in public bureaucracies and the management of both small and large businesses by families and their relatives although these patterns of family life were transformed over time this study demonstrates that such traditions did survive even thrive well into the twentieth century
