a brilliant authoritative and fascinating history of america s most puzzling era the years 1920 to 1933 when the us constitution was amended to restrict one of america s favorite pastimes drinking alcoholic beverages from its start america has been awash in drink the sailing vessel that brought john winthrop to the shores of the new world in 1630 carried more beer than water by the 1820s liquor flowed so plentifully it was cheaper than tea that americans would ever agree to relinquish their booze was as improbable as it was astonishing yet we did and last call is daniel okrent s dazzling explanation of why we did it what life under prohibition was like and how such an unprecedented degree of government interference in the private lives of americans changed the country forever writing with both wit and historical acuity okrent reveals how prohibition marked a confluence of diverse forces the growing political power of the women s suffrage movement which allied itself with the antiliquor campaign the fear of small town native stock protestants that they were losing control of their country to the immigrants of the large cities the anti german sentiment stoked by world war i and a variety of other unlikely factors ranging from the rise of the automobile to the advent of the income tax through it all americans kept drinking going to remarkably creative lengths to smuggle sell conceal and convivially and sometimes fatally imbibe their favorite intoxicants last call is peopled with vivid characters of an astonishing variety susan b anthony and billy sunday william jennings bryan and bootlegger sam bronfman pierre s du pont and h l mencken meyer lansky and the incredible if long forgotten federal official mabel walker willebrandt who throughout the twenties was the most powerful woman in the country perhaps most surprising of all is okrent s account of joseph p kennedy s legendary and long misunderstood role in the liquor business it s a book rich with stories from nearly all parts of the country okrent s narrative runs through smoky manhattan speakeasies where relations between the sexes were changed forever california vineyards busily producing sacramental wine new england fishing communities that gave up fishing for the more lucrative rum running business and in washington the halls of congress itself where politicians who had voted for prohibition drank openly and without apology last call is capacious meticulous and thrillingly told it stands as the most complete history of prohibition ever written and confirms daniel okrent s rank as a major american writer

twenty years ago scott crane abandoned his career as a professional poker player and went into hiding after a weird high stakes game played with tarot cards but now the cards and the supernatural powers behind them have found him again crane s father killed gangster bugsy siegel in 1948 to become the fisher king and to keep that power he is determined to kill his son now scott crane must cross the mojave desert to his father s perilous chapel in las vegas and take up the cards again for one last poker duel and the stakes are the highest he s ever played for his soul winner of the world fantasy award for best novel 1993

an armed violent man escapes jail and flees police in talon county maine where a widespread chase stretches from bangor to portland a torrential rainstorm hits the coast of maine in a fury of blackouts as police canvas the area for brad rayon who terrorizes a small community killing anybody who gets in his way several break ins thefts and arsons are reported in the area but for ash and his boyfriend wally it is a series of personal threats that heightens to life threatening attacks with wally at work ash is alone when he hears the first of many strange noises outside his house it starts with crank calls a heavily obscured voice calling out his name on the other end there are knocks at the front door he hears footsteps in the house somebody walking around and a large shadow filling the corner of a room ash s past is riddled with abuse and violence and he struggles to understand what s real and imagined will ash be the fugitive s next victim or is the ongoing trail of dead bodies a figment of ash s troubled imagination

winner of the edgar award for best fact crime a terrific harrowing true crime account of an elusive serial killer who preyed upon gay men in the 1990s the new york times editor's pick in this astonishing and powerful work of nonfiction green meticulously reports on a series of baffling and brutal crimes targeting gay men it is an investigation filled with twists and turns but this is much more than a compelling true crime story green has shed light on those whose lives for too long have been forgotten and rescued an important part of american history david grann 1 new york times bestselling author of killers of the flower moon the gripping true story told here for the first time of the last call killer and the gay community of new york city that he preyed upon the townhouse bar midtown july 1992 the piano player seems to know every song ever written the crowd belts out the lyrics to their favorites and a man standing nearby is drinking a scotch and water the man strikes the piano player as forgettable he looks bland and inconspicuous not at all what you think a serial killer looks like but that's what he is and tonight he has his sights set on a gray haired man he will not be his first victim nor will he be his last the last call killer preyed upon gay men in new york in the 80s and 90s and had all the hallmarks of the most notorious serial killers yet because of the sexuality of his victims the skyhigh murder rates and the aids epidemic his murders have been almost entirely forgotten this gripping true crime narrative tells the story of the last call killer and the decades long chase to find him and at the same time it paints a portrait of his victims and a vibrant community navigating threat and resilience

franz hasel a 40 year old pacifist was drafted and assigned to pioneer company 699 hitler s elite troops who built bridges at the front lines his religious scruples did not endear him to his superiors sarcastically dubbed carrot eater and bible reader he finally gained the respect of his unit just before he was sent deep into russia where all but seven of his 1 200 man unit would die he secretly discarded his gun fearing that as the company sharpshooter he might be tempted to kill in russia he faced a new problem how to warn the local jews before the ss got to them

a collection of linked stories spanning three generations of one texas family follows events that are both tender and tragic such as a daughter s elopement and a lightning strike that provokes a mother of five to abandon her children winner of the pairie schooner book prize in fiction

you thought you knew how crazy the templeverse could get hold my beer last call is a collection of three drunken novellas set in the templeverse including motherlucker callie and quinn s girls night out in vegas collins quinn s prequel novella to the phantom queen diaries beerlympian gunnar s bachelor party get ready for some shenanigans you might need a drink just to comprehend the insanity

lily pierson s life has been turned upside down now a single mother raising her seven year old twins and finishing up a long and painful divorce she s ready to get her life back on track distractions are not welcome especially in the form of adam byrne her brother s best friend a constant figure in her life who s been absent recently but he won t leave her thoughts nor will the kiss they shared when they were kids a kiss he doesn t remember adam byrne s life is finally where it should be after an injury took away his dream of playing professional hockey and his father passed away adam found himself running the family bar years later and finally happy in his new role he decides to expand the business he s been avoiding lily but she s the best realtor in town so he enlists her help knowing that the more time they spend together the harder it will be to fight what s between them can lily truly let go and give love another chance can adam find happiness with the woman who has been there all along could this be their last call for love

hunter markham left home to travel the world for fame and glory finding it as a top ranked professional surfer now he s returned home to the sand and salty breeze of the north carolina outer banks so he can open the last call a beach bar nestled among the dunes of the atlantic five years ago gabby ward drunkenly threw herself at her best friend s brother only to have her young heart crushed hunter is back but gabby is content to stay far away from him and his dangerously charming ways gabby s well schemed plans to ignore hunter go up in flames when he presents her an offer she simply can t refuse working together day in and day out proves problematic for two reasons gabby realizes her feelings for hunter are still very much alive while hunter struggles to break through to gabby s cold heart what starts out as a mutual business arrangement soon turns into a passion that neither can deny but when the pro surfing tour

comes knocking and hunter has a chance to reclaim his former glory hard choices lie ahead for both of them choices that could destroy what they have built or take them further than they could ever dare to hope in their second chance at romance
